## **The Kunsthaus Zürich reopens on 15 May**

### **All exhibitions planned for 2020 will take place, with revised dates.**

Following the Federal Council's decision on 29 April that the measures designed to protect the population against the coronavirus are to be eased for museums from 11 May, the Kunsthaus Zürich has decided to reopen its doors on Friday 15 May. From 10 a.m., the collection, temporary exhibitions, library, Collection of Prints and Drawings and shop will once again be accessible to visitors.

The exhibitions 'Ottilia Giacometti. A Portrait' and 'The Poetry of Line – Masterpieces of Italian Drawing' are extended until 19 July. 'Smoke and Mirrors – The Roaring Twenties' now begins on 3 July and ends on 11 October. 'Landscapes – Painting Places', which has been rescheduled to run from 17 July to 8 November, will be open during the summer holidays. 'Kader Attia' will now run from 21 August to 15 November, while 'Wild at Heart. Romanticism in Switzerland' has been postponed by nine weeks and will be on show from 13 November 2020 to 14 February 2021. 'Otilie W. Roederstein' opens on 18 December and runs until 5 April 2021.
